Council Eliminates NOC Requirement for Paramedical Registered in Other States; Introduces Fast-Track Registration Process

Mumbai, June 30, 2026

The Maharashtra Paramedical Council (MPMC) has passed a landmark resolution on May 22, 2026, introducing a fast-track registration process for Paramedical practitioners registered with Paramedical councils of other states. This reform has been undertaken in accordance with Priority Area 19 of the Central Government's Deregulation Docket – Phase II, and in pursuance of the directives issued by the Hon'ble Chief Secretary and the Hon'ble Secretary, Medical Education Department, Government of Maharashtra.

Under the erstwhile procedure, Registered Paramedical Practitioners seeking registration in Maharashtra were required to obtain and submit a No Objection Certificate (NOC) from their parent or presently registered state Paramedical council. With the passage of this resolution, this requirement stands abolished.

Henceforth, upon submission of the application along with the requisite documents and a self-declaration, the applicant shall be granted a registration number enabling immediate commencement of Paramedical practice in the State of Maharashtra. The entire registration process will be conducted through the Maharashtra Paramedical Council's dedicated online portal, ensuring transparency, accessibility, and efficiency.

In a significant departure from the earlier practice, the Maharashtra Paramedical Council will independently undertake internal verification with the parent or presently registered state Paramedical council. The responsibility of obtaining and furnishing verification documentation shall no longer vest with the applicant, but shall be assumed entirely by the Council.

This reform marks a decisive step towards simplifying, expediting, and streamlining the registration process for Paramedical professionals who wish to practice in Maharashtra, in keeping with the Government's broader commitment to ease of doing business and reduction of regulatory burden.
